Summary of the rules: All paid-up EMS members, including members of the Executive Board, have one vote. A quorum of 50 members is needed. The General Assembly will be chaired by the President of EMS. Two representatives of ECMA (European Corporate Member Assembly) have voting rights in the General Assembly.
