

Draft minutes of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of EMS

14th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (MCM2019), Belgrade, Serbia

Held at MCM19; Room Session 1, Metropol Palace Wednesday September 18, 2019, from 12:30pm to 2:00pm

According to the Constitution, a General Assembly of all individual EMS members will be held at least once a year. The EMS is a European Society with over 6.500 members. It is important that EMS members gather, discuss and determine the framework in which they communicate and cooperate. Summary of the rules:

All paid-up EMS members, including members of the Executive Board, have one vote. A quorum of 50 members is needed. The General Assembly will be chaired by the President of EMS. Decisions of the General Assembly are taken by a simple majority of votes (except for changes of the statutes).

Two representatives of ECMA (European Corporate Member Assembly) have voting rights in the General Assembly.
