This newsletter has also been published at the I&M journal. The new EMS year has started with many EMS-supported activities. The call for nominations for the EMS Outstanding Paper Awards 2021. EMS has received a significant amount of very high-quality papers, presenting a good balance between the three different categories. The jury will be chaired by Randi Holmestad, and headed by the President José-María Valpuesta.

Both are non-voting members of the jury. The award-winning papers will be announced to the EMS members in May this year in our newsletter, and the authors will receive their awards during the EMS extension, PICO 2022 (8-12 th May 2022; Kateel Vaalsbroek, Netherlands).

This year is special since EMS will have two extensions, the second being the 16th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (MCM16) (4-9th September 2022; Best Western Premier Hotel International Brno, Czech Republic).

At this extension, there will be a variety of opportunities to interact with speakers, exhibitors, and other conference participants. Most important, the General Assembly will be held during this meeting.

The call for Scholarships has been launched at the beginning of January, deadline for applications February 18 (for PICO), and April 1 (for MCM16).

The EMS executive Board will have its first annual meeting end of May this year.
