Some of the most important discussed topics and decisions are mentioned on this newsletter. One of the subjects of high interest was EMC2024. Its preparation, efficiently managed by the conference chair Prof. Klaus Qvortrup, is running as expected. Another important subject was the update of the **EMS** constitution.

The second **EMS** extension event of 2022 will be the 16th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (MCM), to be held from 4 to 9 September 2022, at Best Western Premier Hotel International Brno (Czech Republic). During this congress, two important meetings will take place: the **EMS** Board meeting and the **EMS** General Assembly.
