Dear colleagues,

The new Executive Board of the European Microscopy Society, elected by the EMS General Assembly at EMC2016 in Lyon, met for the first time on March 9-10, Toulouse, France. Several topics were discussed including finances, EMC2016 report, EMC2020 status, sponsored events, scholarships, outstanding papers and new initiatives were extensively scrutinized. During the meeting, the next general assembly has been decided to be held during MC2017, an EMC extension, August 21-25, 2017 in Lausanne, Switzerland at 6:00 p.m.

This year, EMS has received 39 applications for scholarships for attending the two EMC extensions, Microscopy Conference 2017 (MC2017), August 21-25, 2017 in Lausanne, Switzerland and the 13th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (MCM2017), September 24-29, 2017 in Rovinj, Croatia. Thirty-four of those have been selected to receive financial support from EMS to present their results and learn from the specialists in these international environments. We hope to meet most of you at this very stirring events, which will be stated in our next newsletter in October.

The call for EMS Sponsored Events for the second part of 2017 (SE 2017) is closed. The selection for future sponsoring has been made now and the applicants should be informed about the decision on the following days. You may soon find the announcement of the events that were sponsored on the EMS website!

An invitation to all ECMA members (the corporate body of EMS) to renew their membership has been sent at the beginning of this year. Commercial members can now clearly indicate their level of support for European microscopy by selecting between platinum ($\geq \varepsilon$ 1.000), gold (ε 500), silver (ε 250) and bronze (ε 100) membership. The ECMA membership lists at the website and in the Yearbook will reflect this choice, but all companies, regardless their contribution, will receive the same benefits.

In the coming weeks you should receive the 2016 EMS Yearbook. This is again a cross-section of the EMS highlights of the past year and focuses on personal impressions from members, meeting organizers, award winners, scholarship holders, and others points.

A new call for EMC extensions for the year 2018 has been already launched, the deadline for applications is 30th of June, we look forward to receiving your submissions!
